“Summer Olympics Day”

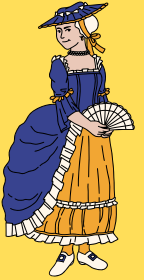
The Summer Olympics started in 1896. Learn the history, engage in some of the sports and find out which Western New York athletes have competed the games.

“A Child’s Life During the American Revolution”

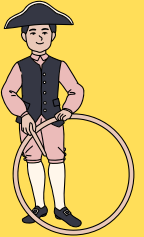
Find out what life was like for a child during the Revolutionary War. Participate in activities, play games and do crafts that were common for a child at that time.
