ALL ABOARD – THE TOUR LOCKPORT TROLLEY STARTS SERVICE

Runs 7 days a week beginning June 30th through September 3rd

LOCKPORT, N.Y. – Looking for a fun way to experience the attractions of historic Lockport and the Erie Canal this summer? Beginning June 30th, hop aboard the Tour Lockport Trolley! Available to visitors and local residents looking to explore area sites, the trolley will shuttle people around the city and between Lockport’s major attractions. With nine stops along the route, riders can see everything Lockport has to offer while listening to a narrated tour. They can also board or disembark the trolley at any site of their choosing along the way.

Made possible with support from the City of Lockport and the Niagara Tourism & Convention Corporation (NTCC), this is the second year that the Lockport attractions have joined forces to offer a combined admission. The Tour Lockport Trolley ticket price is \$24 per adult and \$18 for children age 4 to 10. In addition to providing admission to ticketed attractions- The Erie Canal Discovery Center, Lockport Locks & Erie Canal Cruises and Lockport Cave & Underground Boat Ride- the Tour Lockport Trolley also stops at some of the free attractions including the Colonel Bond House, Niagara County Historical Society, and The Kenan Center, some of which have limited hours of operation. For the convenience of out-of-town guests the trolley will also stop at the Holiday Inn Lockport. Tickets are valid for a single entry to each paid attraction any day from June 30th through September 4th and include unlimited trolley transportation during your visit.
